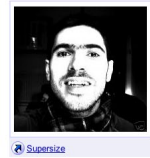

I graduated from Northumbria University in 2003 with a 1st Class Degree in 3Dre Dimensional Design. As part of my degree I designed a variety of furniture pieces including a bookshelf, a collection of stools, a bench, a chair and a birdtable.

My shelf design 'Bookend' won the Hettich International Design Award '03, and in conjunction with the family of 'Mr Stools', I received the Peter Walker Award for Innovation in Furniture Design at New Designers 2003.

Inspiration grows from my desire to explore and re-contextualise both traditional and unconventional materials, exploiting their inherent qualities, and to consider / reconsider the function of all products and objects. I aim to design products that are fun, inspired and inspiring, and stimulate positive interaction between product and user. Interaction develops product meaning and meaning improves product longevity. I try to design products that possess a visual simplicity capable of communicating the obvious.

After graduating I worked as a design consultant for Otu Baholyodhin Studio in London, where I became accustomed to all aspects of the design business. My responsibilities included designing furniture, graphics, and interior products, as well as entire interior spaces for restaurants, shops, exhibitions and private domestic interiors. Simultaneously, driven by my desire to one day establish my own design practice, I continued to develop my own range of products and furniture.

I have just completed a two month position as a freelance designer for Tom Dixon. During this post I worked on a variety of design projects, notably furniture, lighting, packaging and outdoor public sculpture for Artek, Habitat and Tom Dixon.

Currently I am in my second year studying for a Masters Degree in Design Products at the Royal College of Art. Here I hope to explore further creative and intellectual possibilities in furniture and interior product design and establish a concise design philosophy.

Beyond work I am a keen international traveller, always taking interest in the influence of local and globalised cultures on design, and observing the ingenuity of everyday people solving problems to make their lives more efficient. These improvisations are fundamental to life, and survival, and at the heart of design.
